COMMITTEE COMPOSITION

The Founder's Award Selection Committee members should consist of experienced members within Tipisa Lodge. The award recognizes a long span of exceptional, profound service to the lodge, and a committee comprised of knowledgeable youth allows for effective discussion on all nominees. An example for such a member are Chapter Chiefs.

The committee will be comprised of one representative from each chapter and the Founder's Award Committee Chairman. The Founder's Award Committee Chairman does not vote.

A meeting time will be advertised when member recruitment begins. Potential recruited members will consist of an experienced chapter member volunteering to serve on the committee.

Members of the Selection Committee waive their eligibility for the Founder's Award that term.

The Selection Meeting will be held on 14 January 2017 at Camp La-No-Che.

SELECTION MEETING PROCEDURES

Nominations by email for the Founder's Award will be collected just before the meeting begins on 14 January 2017. Reference the Founder's Award Nomination Guideline on tipisa.org/awards. Nominations for the award during the meeting will be allowed from the floor.

The Founder's Award Chairman will read all submitted email nominations, call for any nominations from the floor before initial discussion begins.

Following discussions, blind votes narrows nominations until few nominees remain. Members of the Selection Committee adhere to strict confidentiality regarding nominees and runoff voting results. Final voting results are confidential to the Founder's Award Chairman and Adviser.

Results of the selection will be announced at the following Spring Conclave, tentatively scheduled for 10–12 March 2017 at Camp La-No-Che
