Introduced at the 1981 National Order of the Arrow Conference, the Founder's Award was created to honor and recognize those Arrowmen who have given outstanding service to their lodge. The award is reserved for those Arrowmen who demonstrate to their peers that they memorialize in their everyday lives the spirit of achievement and selflessness described by founder E. Urner Goodman and cofounder Carroll A. Edson. It is generally awarded to two Arrowmen a year (one adult and one youth) who have shown selfless service over a long period of time.
